

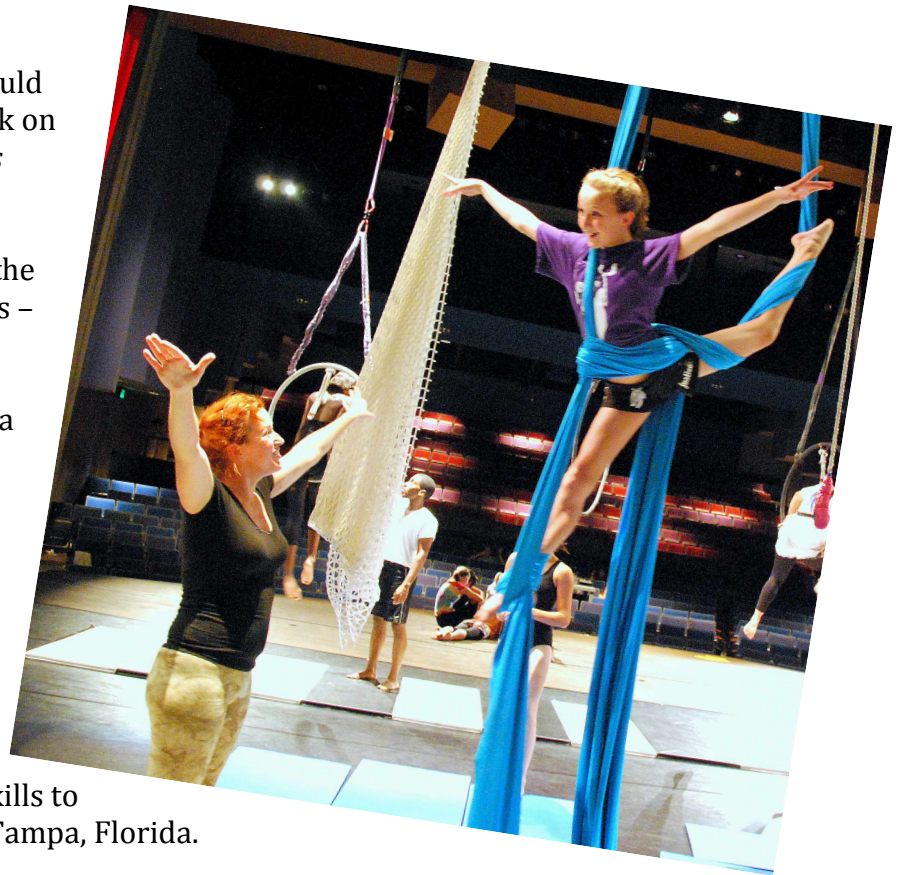

Award-Winning Circus Artists to Teach in Durham
